# Gdansk Lech Walesa Airport

GDANSK, POLAND

An international airport located in the Martania district of Gdansk, 10 km from the centre of Gdansk and Sopot.

The official opening took place on 2 May 1974. Gdansk airport meets the requirements and recommendations of the International Civil Aviation Organisation (ICAO) and follows the practices described in the AIP collection of aviation information. The number of passengers handled classifies Gdańsk Airport as a regional main airport and it is currently the 3rd Polish airport behind Warsaw Chopin Airport, and Kraków Balice. The airport has around 95 scheduled connections to ports in the country and in Europe and a constantly growing number of charter connections. The airport is a backup airport for Warsaw's Chopin Airport.
