Swina Underwater Tunnel

SWINOUJSCIE, POLAND

A road tunnel running beneath the bed of the Świna river in Świnoujście, connecting the islands of Uznam and Wolin and the city centre of Świnoujście with the rest of the country.

The tunnel was officially opened on 30 June 2023. The Świna Tunnel is the longest underwater crossing in Poland. The combined length of the tunnel and its approach roads is nearly 3.2 km, with the tunnel itself measuring 1.5 km. The internal diameter of the tunnel is 12 metres, accommodating a two-way carriageway with 3.5-metre lanes as well as an evacuation passage. The total investment cost exceeded PLN 912 million.

The facility is inaccessible to pedestrians, cyclists, and vehicles other than motor cars or those carrying hazardous materials. Within one month of opening, the tunnel had been used by 500,000 vehicles.
