The Struma highway in western Bulgaria, also known as the A3/E79 motorway, is an important transport link.

It connects the Bulgarian capital Sofia with the town of Kulata, close to the Greek border in the south. The road stretches for 149 km, officially starting in Dolna Dikanya southwest of Sofia. "Zheleznitsa" on the "Struma" highway is the longest road tunnel ever built in Bulgaria and the first to be equipped with a certified audible warning system.

The tunnel has two separate openings for travel in opposite directions, with a length of 2 km. The corridors have all the necessary systems for energy-efficient lighting, ventilation, monitoring, fire alarm, intelligent traffic management.
