Crane

GDANSK, POLAND

The Gdansk Crane is a unique example of a medieval harbour crane on a European scale, being the largest and oldest structure of its kind in Europe.

It owes its original form, dating back to the mid-15th century, to its dual function as a city gate and port crane. The exhibition inside takes visitors back to the harbour city of Gdańsk during the “Golden Age”, i.e. the 17th century heyday of Polish shipping and maritime trade. A two-year modernisation of the building was completed in 2024. During the work, the bricks below ground were drained and the wooden elements of the entire structure were conserved, among other things.
